

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WITHDRAWAL

Please be aware that if you withdraw or are dropped from classes during a payment period (semester), you are subject to the Return of Title IV Funds calculation as regulated by the Department of Education.

You may owe back part or all of your grant money and loans to the federal programs. If so, you will not be eligible to receive additional Title IV financial aid until the refund is repaid.

You will be responsible for paying any outstanding balance created on your NOC account as a result of the federal government's requirement that NOC return Title IV funds. This provision applies regardless of which funds actually paid institutional charges. For example: A student may have received a tuition waiver or scholarship which actually paid tuition and fees, but NOC is still required to return a portion of the institutional charges assessed. You will not be allowed to re-enroll or receive any records at NOC until these charges are paid. A 'hold' will be placed on your records.

If you withdraw from a late start class or weekend seminar before it begins, we may be required to reduce your Pell grant funds if the withdrawal changes your enrollment status (i.e. from FT to $\frac{3}{4}$ time or $\frac{3}{4}$ time to $\frac{1}{2}$ time). You cannot be paid for classes you never attend.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

A student **cannot** receive federal financial aid from two schools for the same period of enrollment. If you plan to enroll in classes at two institutions during one semester (i.e. 6 hours at NOC and 6 hours at NWOSU), please see a Financial Aid Counselor to determine if a consortium agreement needs to be set up. Under a consortium agreement, you would receive payment based on the total number of hours you were enrolled in at both schools. **If you are enrolled in ANY classes at OSU, you must apply for federal aid through OSU, not NOC.**

SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR NOC STILLWATER STUDENTS

Bookstore: You may charge your books to your financial aid at the NOC Tonkawa bookstore. If you are unable to come to the Tonkawa campus, you may order books on the internet at www.nocbookstore.com or you may call 580-628-6771. Orders will be processed and sent by courier to the Stillwater NOC campus within 3 business days for pick-up.

If you charge your books at the OSU bookstore, NOC will **not** pay the charges for you. You will be billed by OSU.

OSU on campus housing: NOC will **not** pay these charges for you. **You are responsible for paying all housing charges owed to OSU.**
