Brent Price

University of Oklahoma basketball legend and 11 year NBA veteran, Brent has given his life to the game he loves. At the University of Oklahoma he averaged 18ppg, scored 56 points against Loyola-Marymount, held an NCAA record with 11 of 19 threes in a game, while leading the Sooners in assists, steals and three pointers. Brent was drafted by the Washington Bullets where he scored 30pts against Michael Jordan's Chicago Bulls and set the consecutive three point record with 13 which still stands. Brent later played with NBA greats Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler, and Charles Barkley with the Houston Rockets. Then was traded to the Vancouver Grizzlies and finished his career with the Sacramento Kings which reached the Western Conference Finals in 2001.

Northern Oklahoma College-Enid Head Men's Coach has 27 seasons of college and professional experience. Coach Shamburg has been a part of 6 Conference Championships, 3 National Tournament Appearances, compiled over 500 wins, 16 twenty win seasons, 2-time Conference Coach of the Year, 2017 Sweet 16 Appearance, nominated for National Coach of the Year, and recruited and coached over 70 NCAA I Players.
