



## Transferring to OSU

### Are You Ready to Transfer?

1.) Do you have 24 or more college credit hours? Yes  NO

2.) Do you have at least a 2.25 GPA? Yes  No

If you answered YES to BOTH of these questions you are ready to transfer to OSU.

**If you answered NO to question 2 then....**

A) Do you have at least a 2.0 GPA and 60 or more college credit hours? Yes  No

If you answered YES you are ready to transfer to OSU.

\*\*There may be additional steps for students applying for readmission.

### Transfer Checklist

- APPLY ONLINE** Apply at <https://admissions.okstate.edu/apply>  
*To earn an Associate's Degree through Reverse Transfer you must select YES to the application question requesting your consent for your OSU transcript to be shared with any community college you previously attended.*

\*To print your application go to: <https://admissions.okstate.edu/apply/how>

- APPLICATION FEE** Pay the \$40 application fee online, or by check, cash or money order or apply for an application fee waiver.

- SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS** Submit official transcripts from each institution you've attended.

Electronic transcript form: eSCRIPT-SAFE, Parchment/Naviance/Avow/Docufide, OKCollegeStart (XAP), National Clearinghouse, Credential Solutions, Join Service Transcripts (military JST)

Electronic transcripts in PDF format sent directly from the university/college's email account (.edu) to the Office of the Undergraduate Admissions' email account – [admissions@okstate.edu](mailto:admissions@okstate.edu)

Transcript mailed or hand delivered with a print date within three (3) months of the received date to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions in a sealed envelope from the institution

- SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA** Use school code 003170

Click the link LOGIN FOR STUDENT SERVICES STARTING (THE SEMESTER YOU APPLIED FOR)

Click UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS LOGIN

Enter the email address and password you used to CREATE your application.
