Residence Hall Policies

In following Regents' policy, Northern Oklahoma College believes that the experience of living in college housing is important to a student's education. Therefore, just as there are required courses, all students are required to live in college housing to the extent that facilities are available with the following exceptions:

- 1) Students living with parents or legal guardians.
- 2] Students 21 years of age or older.
- **3**] Students who are married and/or have children.
- 4) Students with veteran status.
- 5] Students that have completed 31 or more credit hours.

All students who are on participation scholarships are required to reside in resident housing regardless of freshman or sophomore classification.

Any student who feels exceptions would apply to his/her circumstance and who wishes to be released from the requirements to live in residence halls must contact the Vice President for Student Affairs prior to moving off grounds.

- A \$75 room deposit must accompany each application. The room deposit is non-refundable. If a situation develops after the start of school which may be cause for cancellation, please notify the Office of Student Affairs. This application is invalid without the \$75.
- This contract does not include payment for room or food service during official college vacations (such as Fall Break, Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break and Spring Break) during which halls will be closed.
- The college may reassign or adjust occupancy of rooms in order that the rate of occupancy may be maximized.

Any student residing in college housing is required to choose a meal plan. No refund is made for unused meals. Meal tickets are non-transferable. Students are to abide by the rules and regulations of Mavericks Cafe and Memorial Student Union.
