The following is <u>an example</u> 8-semester plan. This is used to illustrate the course sequencing and the expectations for course loading. It is mandatory for a student to meet with an academic advisor prior to course enrollment each semester.

## Oklahoma State University Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- 40 hours must be upper-division
- A 2.75 Major GPA is required for graduation.
- A 2.75 College/Departmental GPA is required for graduation.
- A 2.75 minimum overall GPA required for graduation.
- At least: 60 hours at a four-year institution; 30 hours completed at OSU; 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours.
