The OBN recommended to "continue to assess factors impacting student success in the program and implement actions to improve the completion rate while still maintaining an adequate NCLEX rate." The faculty continue to assess factors systematically to identify ways to help students be successful.

Elsevier Clinical Skills, Adaptive Quizzing, Online Pharmacology and HESI proctored exams were initiated this year. Students and faculty have voiced an increase in satisfaction of use, customer service and knowledge obtainment. The Elsevier NCLEX review was also used. A complete comprehensive assessment of student learning was conducted at the end of each course to assess student improvement and need for curriculum changes.

ACEN recommended that we "revise our program documents to ensure that the information intended to inform the public is clear, consistent and accessible." NOC as a college and the nursing program have been very transparent in our reporting of data. The web page and the NOC Fact Book clearly state our retention rates, NCLEX pass rates, and student demographics. ACEN Self-Study, yearly Advisory Meeting minutes and the yearly OBN report are posted in full, for transparency. ACEN also reiterated the importance of evaluating each site before aggregating the data for the program as a whole. Statistics are evaluated per campus and as a whole.

### Program Update

Please share any information regarding program activities, accomplishments, or challenges.

Clinical spots continue to be difficult with the decrease in acute and long-term care facilities in rural areas of Northern Oklahoma. Students drive farther to get experiences once found in closer proximity to the college. Clinical facilities are also decreasing the number of students allowed on a unit at one time increasing the need for faculty. With the increasing number of faculty required and the annual decrease in budget, the department continues to look for ways to accommodate. Simulations are currently set at 10% of clinical hours. If the percentage were to increase this would help with the decrease in facility slots; however, the faculty availability would continue to be an issue.
