#### All donations\* will be tested\*\* for COVID-19 antibodies to identify potential convalescent plasma donors.

Appointments preferred, to help with social distancing. Walk-ins accepted as schedule allows. Masks required for all donors. Donors ages 16 or 17-years old need parental consent to be screened for COVID-19 antibodies and are not eligible to donate convalescent plasma. \*\*This test has not been FDA cleared or approved. It has been authorized by the FDA under an EUA (Emergency Use Authorization) for use by authorized laboratories. The test has been authorized only for the detection of the IgG antibody against SARS-CoV-2, not for any other viruses or pathogens. Blood drives will be managed according to CDC safety recommendations. Test results will be made available post-donation.






