The purpose of the President's Leadership Council (PLC) is to provide an organization whose purposes are to develop and promote scholarship and leadership qualities at Northern Oklahoma College, to provide support for and to be used as a recruitment tool for Northern. Membership is open to all students who have the Presidential Leadership Scholarship, the NOC/OSU Gateway Ambassador Scholarship, or the State Regents Academic Scholarship.

Presidential Leadership Scholarship

Awarded at the Tonkawa and Enid locations, this scholarship is based on academic and leadership achievements [25 ACT, 3.6 GPA]. This scholarship includes: up to \$7,000 per semester of NOC related expenses, i.e., tuition, fees, books, on-campus room and board for 4 semesters. **Deadline is February 20.**

NOC/OSU Gateway Ambassadors Scholarship

Awarded at the Stillwater location, this scholarship is based on academic and leadership achievements [25 ACT, 3.6 GPA]. This scholarship includes: up to \$7,000 per semester of NOC related expenses, i.e., tuition, fees, books for 4 semesters. **Deadline is February 20.**

State Regents Academic Scholarship

Established by the state legislature and governor in 1988 and operated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the Academic Scholars provides scholarships to academically outstanding students who attend an Oklahoma college or university. This scholarship covers full tuition, plus \$1,100 cash per semester, transferable to any Oklahoma university for 4 years or 8 semesters. Recipient also has the option of joining PLC.

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria to qualify:

- Achieve designation as a National Merit Scholar.
- High School GPA of at least 3.70 and 26 ACT or SAT Equivalent.

To be considered for scholarships, applicants are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov [Northern's Title IV Institutional Code is 003162] within 30 days of accepting a scholarship award. NOTE: All financial aid will be primary source of funding education. Best consideration date for financial aid is **March 1**.
