Weekly Pandemic Situation Update
Reporting Period: 12/5-12/11

Northern Oklahoma College will be reporting weekly on positive cases and required quarantine cases associated with students, faculty and staff in an effort to keep all informed with the most recent data collected at the time of the report. This report includes 3 tables. Table 1 provides numbers on individuals with positive COVID-19 tests and persons quarantined from primary contact for all three NOC locations along with off-campus individuals who were never physically present at an NOC location (e.g. online, concurrent, UC). Table 2 provides data for individuals in residence halls that are in isolation in college-sponsored quarantine locations (these numbers are also included in the first chart).
