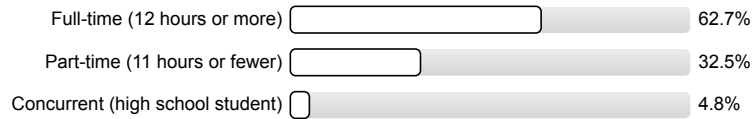

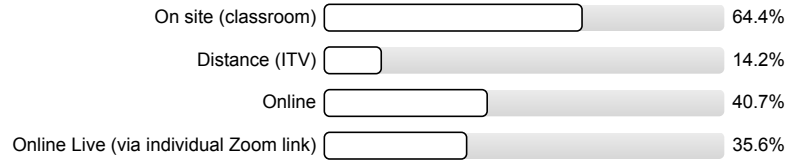

- Although I am currently a concurrent student from Stillwater High School, I applied to the RN nursing program for Fall 2021. I made application late January. I did not receive notification that my application was even received. As of today, I still have no idea if am accepted. All of my friends know where they are going to school next Fall, and many even know about their housing. Application process and communication is very difficult.
- As a non-traditional student I was offered no assistance about how the whole thing worked and had to just wing it till I figured things out on my own. Noone to really guide me or help me through any of the processes including my current graduation arrangements.
- Enrolling in College is always a challenge--I wish there was a definite checklist that we could look at to make sure we have completed all the steps.
- Enrollment was always posted everywhere.
- Every step was an Unnecessary challenge and often no help was provided
- Had a hard time getting the right class with the new advising system.
- I had a lot of difficulty getting enrolled. The information I was given regarding applying for the nursing program such as dates of knowing about acceptance and denial was incorrect. My paperwork was screwed up greatly and I have been required to call and send multiple emails to get things straightened out and I am still worried it may not be all correct and complete. When I was told a certain date that I would know more information about my program application and that date ended up being wrong (2 full months early) I really worried about the status of my records and my application not being considered and this stressed me out beyond all reason.
- I always receive emails when I need to do something.
- I contacted them about everything
- I feel that NOC could improve on communication overall.
- I had to communicate extensively with the nursing program on what my next steps were for enrollment. They were good at answering and maybe it's just because I've been out of school for awhile.
- I had to do everything on my own with my friend's help. My counselor only sent in my high school transcript.
- I had to email someone about my enrollment and they gave me to run around.
- I had to go back and forth between the registrars office and my student advisor several times.
- I received several emails from XXX, but for my particular situation it was not well explained.
- I was previously enrolled and my enrollment was chaotic to say the least. No clear pathway.
- If I had not reached out to XXX, I don't know that I would have got to enroll.
- It was a very confusing trying to get everything set up for my enrollment, and the NOC staff was not very helpful.
- It was an absolute nightmare trying to get enrolled in the class! Thank God for Mrs. XXX patience and communication.
- It was fine up until they switched programs to do all of the enrollment on. Our professors now can't help us with anything. With nursing being the one degree program of NOCs that is needed to have transcripts out to take boards, we should take precedence.
- It was hard to get someone to help me. Everytime I called I got sent to someone else. Then they changed the enrollment process and it was harder and no one could really help you

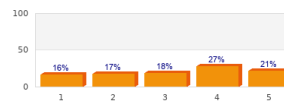
3.2) Comment 3.1

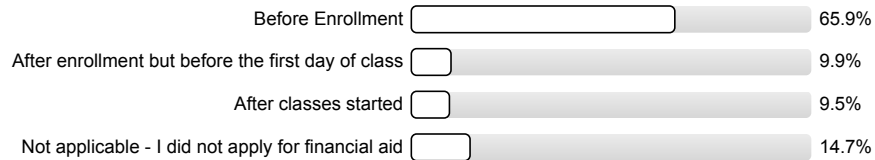
3.7) Please recommend improvement to the financial aid page on the NOC website.

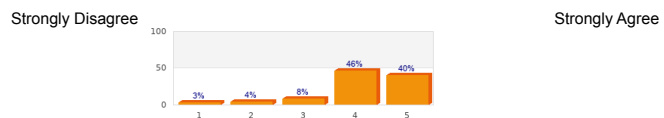

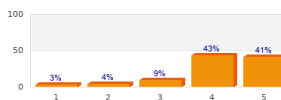

- I feel as though there are many things that could change. The fact that the highest grades in our class are typically B's and majority of people are just barely passing, there is an issue with teaching styles and/or the test.
- I felt sick and I could not complete.
- I had to take an additional class prior to leaving NOC, because my advisor was misinformed and was not aware of the current rules and regulations in place.
- I have taken General Chemistry 1 twice in the past year and I have failed once and am currently failing again. I will not be passing Gen. Chem. 1 this semester, which means I will not be graduating with an associated degree on time. This is the last credit I need for my Associate's degree. Both times taking the course I was working up to my full potential, but the professors made it IMPOSSIBLE to pass the class. By barely doing to bare minimum, the professors expect you to succeed in the class. I cannot succeed when they don't even give me the means to.

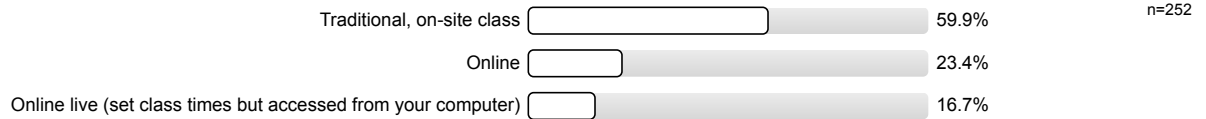

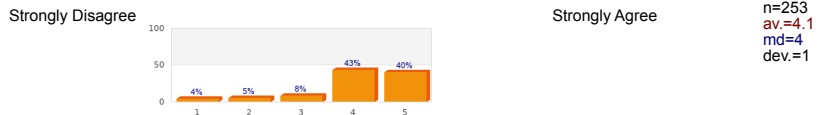

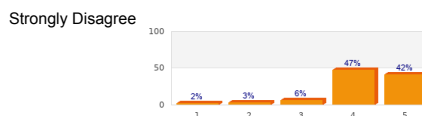


5.2) Comment 5.1

Just give us 10 questions that the teacher comes up with based on what they taught us and then we go over it in our next class. HESI/Evolve was not beneficial for me. It was just more reading.
- I found instructors helpful, but the main office has a serious break down that needs to be addressed.
- I have never had so many professors who do not care. I dont know if it is because of covid or because most of these are online courses but this has been the least professional group of teachers. I have a class that almost every single assignment was posted to black board late, like at the last minute, or even after the assignment was due, or not at all. As a student I am expected to complete all of my work and have it turned in by a date. I take this seriously and I spent more time emailing my professor asking where the assignments were so I could complete them. I have another teacher that doesnt grade things for over a month sometimes longer. I have another professor that didnt tell anyone the syllabus was wrong and I was going by the assignment schedule on the syllabus and spent two weeks reading something that I didnt even have to read. 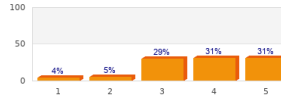
- Financial Aid has been less than helpful and is quite rude every time I need help with something. I have gotten to the point that I would rather not contact them.

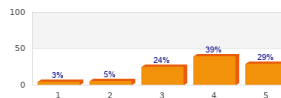

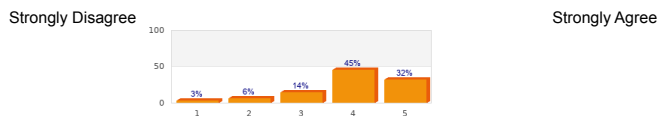
