Lady Jets rout NOC Tonkawa 86-62

NOC Enid won Bedlam Round 1 with an 86-62 win over NOC Tonkawa Monday night at the Mabee Center.

The Lady Jets (2-5) improved to 2-1 in conference while NOC Tonkawa (6-6) fell to 2-1 in conference play.

NOC Enid was led by LaKysia Johnson with 24 points while Aleisha Hester added 20. Tegan Jones chipped in with 16 while Jade Hazelbaker added 13.

"So proud of what this team did tonight," said coach Kelli Jennings. "They work hard every day and needed this win to start building some momentum. We know the team we can be and tonight was a glimpse of that."

The Lady Jets jumped out to a hot start opening a 17-7 lead after the first 10 minutes. Enid then went on a 20-7 run late in the second quarter to take a 41-24 halftime lead.

The Lady Mavs cut the lead to 14 in the third quarter but that's as close as they would get as NOC Enid poured it on in the second half building a lead as big as 31 points.

Hazelbaker and Johnson had seven rebounds each, Hazelbaker added six assists.

NOC Tonkawa was led by Jordan Holman with 21.

The Lady Jets travel to Southwest Christian JV on Friday, their final game of the fall semester.

NOC Enid is 1-2 in conference play heading into the break, they face Western on Jan. 5 in Altus.

ENID, Oklahoma – Lynn Counter scored 24 points but it wasn't enough as NOC Enid fell to NOC Tonkawa 75-63 in the Mabee Center.

The Jets (3-7) fell to 0-3 in conference while the Mavs (8-3) improved to 3-0.

Jlynn Counter led the Jets with 24 while Quentin Harvey added 14 and Dakoda Joachim 10. Harvey had 11 rebounds while Counter added 10 rebounds and three assists.

"NOC Bedlam games are always fun with a great atmosphere and energy, I thought both teams competed hard," said coach Chris Gerber. "I thought we showed a lot of toughness and we matured a little bit. The main thing we have to build on is keeping that toughness consist and taking the easy points when we can. We have four more games before we get a break, need to build on last night and finish the semester strong."

The Jets took a 14-13 midway in the first half but NOC Tonkawa went on a run to take a 39-27 lead at half.

NOC Tonkawa then went on a 9-2 run early in the second half building a 48-29 lead but the Jets battled back with a 12-2 run of their own to get back in the game.

The Jets made one final push cutting the lead to 56-49 with 9:39 left but the Mavs answered with a 15-5 run building the lead to 71-54.


