NOC Tonkawa is hosting a mobile wellness center on the second and fourth Monday of each month. The next event will be Monday, Jan. 24

The center will be located in the Renfro Center parking lot from 9 a.m. – noon and 1 p.m. – 4 p.m.

Services offered by the mobile wellness unit include Immunizations, COVID-19 testing and vaccinations, WIC services, pregnancy testing, blood pressure screenings and other public health services.

Matt Adams, Coordinating Nurse for the mobile wellness unit, states, "We are excited to offer our services to the in the community. We

realize that access to our county health departments can be a challenge for some. We hope to fill that gap by bring the mobile unit to the areas that need us."

OSDH District 3 serves a seven-county region including Creek, Kay, Lincoln, Noble, Osage, Pawnee and Payne Counties.

The "Mobile Health on the Go" mobile wellness unit is part of a statewide fleet mobilized earlier this year by OSDH to help reach underserved communities with vital services, including the COVID-19 vaccine.
