Dear Agricultural Educators,

The 2022 Northern Oklahoma College Agriculture Interscholastic Meet will be held Wednesday, January 26. We will again be awarding a Single-teacher and a Multi-teacher Sweepstakes award in which points will be tabulated from all interscholastic contests. Since the livestock judging contest is held to a later date, it WILL NOT be tabulated as part of the Sweepstakes award. This year's contest will offer competition in the divisions of Ag Communications, Ag Mechanics, Agronomy, Dairy Foods, Entomology, Horticulture Landscape/Nursery, Farm Business Management, Food Science & Technology, Meat Science Evaluation and Veterinary Science. Contestants may only compete in one contest area.

**Note:** Contests will be limited to **2 teams and 2 individuals per contest area**. A team may consist of 3 or 4 members with the top 3 scores for placing scores. **Exceptions include:** 

- 1) Ag Mechanics: There will be a limit of one Junior (Freshmen and Sophomores) and one Senior (Juniors and Seniors) team (no individuals) per school for the Ag Mechanics contest. Contestants need to bring their own safety glasses, welding helmets, welding gloves, a pair of pliers and appropriate clothing and footwear. We will score the top 3 of 4 contestant teams.
- 2) Veterinary Science: There will be a limit of one team per school and **no individual** contestants. Each team must consist of 4 members and ALL SCORES are used in tabulation.

The pre-entry deadline is January 21, 2022. The PRE-ENTRY fee for all contests except Ag Mechanics and Veterinary Science is \$20.00 per team and \$5.00 per individual. Entries received the DAY OF the contest will be \$30.00 per team and \$7.00 per individual. Ag Mechanics and Veterinary Science PRE-ENTRY fee will be \$30 per team and DAY OF entries will be \$40 per team. NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Payment must be cash, cashiers check, or school check. Please make checks payable to NOC Aggie Club.

In order to qualify for the preentry rate, entries must be returned on the entry form WITH THE CONTESTANT'S NAMES LISTED. Changes may be made the day of the contest. Entry fees need not accompany the registration form but must be paid/received the morning of the contest in order for your kids to compete.
