Navigation of the university website is often clumsy and non functional on Safari, requiring a browser swap. The menu system has too many nested layers and buttons I don't need drowning out the ones I do. There is no public Q/A system for instructors to answer FAQ like what one might see with the majority of other market products that don't create so much debt. Individual instructor class policy should be

listed with each instructor. Class selection, while functional with a browser swap, is somehow uniquely awful in terms of available useful information per pixel and overall UI. My original class schedule was disrupted by this bad UI and I had to choose different courses due to scheduling and location conflicts. Despite this, AJAX performance is relatively snappy.

- I took a lot of maths in high school and on khan academy, and this algebra course was mostly review material. What I needed was precalculus. The school's policy of over-reliance on test results is to blame.
- I was enrolled in certain courses backwards making me take the harder classes prior to the recommended beginning courses.
- It seemed as though no matter the amount of studying, tutoring, meeting with professors, test review and remediation it was not good enough to excel in this program. I know the grades I am capable of and I know how hard I was working to do well in this RN program and the tests were honestly ridiculous. I know nursing school is hard and the testing process is supposed to be difficult; however, this was beyond all reason. When nearly 80 percent of the class had failed out or dropped out by mid second semester I realized there was/is an issue. I attempted to discuss my issues with the dean and was never able to. I brought my concerns to the nursing department and I was advised to try another program. Two days after I officially withdrew from the program I received an email from the school telling me they are contemplating repeating this semester because of the high rate of failure. That tells me there is an issue with the program; especially, since this is the second class to have to repeat a course in a row. It just seems problematic and I think the testing process needs to be reviewed. The rationales for the test questions got to be where they were several paragraphs long and reaching in multiple ways. On 4 different occasions when I reviewed my exam with a professor and I explained MY rational they said they agreed with me and didn't really understand what the test writer was saying.
