High school junior tuition waivers

Northern Oklahoma College Regents approved a measure Wednesday that allows high school juniors to receive a concurrent enrollment tuition waiver.

The tuition waiver for academically qualified their college experience." high school juniors will be available starting in Fall 2022. Juniors are eligible to take up to nine college credit hours per year. The tuition waiver does not include academic fees or books.

The Oklahoma legislature approved the tuition session.

"This is a great opportunity for high school students to earn college credit at a greatly

reduced cost to their families," said NOC President Dr. Clark Harris. "We are so pleased the legislature is waiving tuition for juniors, this will help so many students get a head start on

Currently, seniors have been eligible to participate in the tuition waiver program while juniors could take college courses did not receive a tuition waiver.

A student taking full advantage of the program waiver for juniors in the most recent legislative may earn as many as 27 college credit hours during high school, nine (9) credit hours during the junior year and 18 credit hours during the senior year.

Stillwater Nursing apps accepted

The Northern Oklahoma College Nursing Program will accept applications for spring semester 2023 start on the Stillwater campus through Oct. 1.

Applicants must meet minimum program requirements for admission and be accepted to Northern Oklahoma College prior to acceptance in the Nursing Program. Applicants are selected based on qualifications and space availability.

NOC has nursing programs at Tonkawa, Enid, and Stillwater locations. Apply by March 1 for admission on all three campuses for fall semester 2023.

Last season, both NOC teams were ranked in the Top 20 during the season, the women finished 15-4 while the men were 13-4-2.


The Mavs and Lady Mavs open the season Wednesday, Aug. 24 at Cowley College (KS).


