Native Forward Scholars Fund

Award Amount: Amount Varies

Degree Level: Be a degree-seeking student attending a U.S. accredited institution recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or the Council for Higher

Education.



American Indian Services

Award Amount: Scholarship Awards are based on up to one-half of tuition and need for the term the student is applying for. Degree Level: Enrolled or will enroll as a

matriculated student in a university, college, junior college or technical school (incoming

freshman accepted).
