

# Outside Scholarship Opportunities for Native Americans



## Cobell Undergraduate

**Award Amount:** Up to \$10,000

**Degree Level:** 2-year or 4-year degree program at an accredited, public or private non-profit, institution of higher education.



## American Indian College Fund

**Award Amount:** Average between \$2,000 and \$3,000


**Degree Level:** Students enrolled in certificate, undergraduate, or graduate programs at accredited public or private, non-profit college or university in the U.S.



## Native Forward Scholars Fund

**Award Amount:** Amount Varies

**Degree Level:** Be a degree-seeking student attending a U.S. accredited institution recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or the Council for Higher Education.



## American Indian Services

**Award Amount:** Scholarship Awards are based on up to one-half of tuition and need for the term the student is applying for.

**Degree Level:** Enrolled or will enroll as a matriculated student in a university, college, junior college or technical school (incoming freshman accepted).

**Ensure to monitor these programs closely, as deadlines vary and are subject to frequent changes.**
