



# **How Your Recipient Can Whitelist Your Email**

### How to whitelist an email in Gmail:

- Log into your Gmail account.
- Click the gear icon in the upper-right corner and choose "See all settings" from the drop-down.



- Go to the "Filters and blocked addresses" tab to view your current filters and blocked addresses.
- Click "Create a new filter" and input the email address or domain (@noc.edu) you want to whitelist in the
  "From" field.



- After that, click "Create filter" and make sure to select "Never send to spam" to ensure the emails are
  whitelisted.
- **Note:** To whitelist a single sender, type the entire address. On the other hand, if you're trying to whitelist every sender from a certain domain, type the domain alone, such as "@noc.edu". This will set Gmail spam settings to approve every message from an NOC sender.

# How to Whitelist an Email in Gmail Application (Android & iOS)

Unlike the desktop version, you can't access your filters and blocked addresses on Mobile devices (irrespective of iOS or Android). Instead, what you can do is add a sender's email address to your contact list. This will give them uninterrupted access to sending email to you.

## And to whitelist an email from your spam folder in Gmail in iOS devices, follow these steps:

- 1. Open your spam folder and locate the email you wish to whitelist.
- 2. At the top of the message, you'll notice a gray box with the option "Report as not spam."
- 3. Click this button to inform Google that you want to receive future emails from this sender.
- 4. Alternatively, you can tap the three dots in the upper right corner of the email and select the same option.

## Here's how you can whitelist an email in Android:

- 1. Launch the "Contacts" app.
- 2. Tap the "Add contact" button located at the bottom left.
- 3. Fill in the contact's name and email address, ensuring it's linked to the correct account.
- 4. Once completed, press "Save" to store the contact.

# Whitelisting Emails in Other Email Service Providers

#### How to Whitelist an Email in Outlook:

- 1. After logging into your Microsoft Outlook account, click on the "**Settings**" (gear icon) in the upper-right corner.
- 2. From the menu, choose the "Mail" option.
- 3. In the next submenu, select "Junk email."
- 4. Input the email address you wish to whitelist and click "Save" to complete the process.

### How to Whitelist an Email in Yahoo Mail:

- 1. Go to "**Settings**" on the right side of your screen.
- 2. Select "More Settings" from the dropdown menu.
- 3. Click on "Filters" to view your filters.
- 4. Press "Add New Filter" and type in the email address or domain (@noc.edu) you want to whitelist.
- 5. Click "Save" to finish.

### How to Whitelist an Email in AOL:

- 1. Click "Contacts" from the left-side menu.
- 2. Tap the three dots in the upper-right corner and choose "Add a new contact."
- 3. Fill in the details, then click "Save" to add the email to your contacts.

## How do I whitelist multiple addresses in Gmail?

To whitelist multiple addresses in Gmail, you can create a filter and enter multiple email addresses separated by commas in the "From" field. This way, you can ensure emails from different senders are directed to your inbox.
