### Minimum Grade Requirements

- 1. Average in (a) all college course work, (b) course work at UCO......2.50
- 2. Average in the major......2.75
- 3. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in all courses in the major.

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
