ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT

This degree is offered as an Associate in Science or as an Associate in Arts. It is a flexible business degree that includes the most desirable core competencies requested by employers and provides a degree completion framework that matches student aspirations with the needs of industry. BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION*

With 60 credit hours designed to provide the student with the first two years of general requirements for transfer to a four-year institution. This degree has options in Management Information Systems and International Business. It can be completed in a fast-track format in as little as one year.

BUSINESS MANAGEMENT*

This degree is designed to provide the student with the necessary skills for immediate employment into entry-level management. The degree can be completed in conjunction with the Associate in Science in Business Administration, allowing a student to graduate from Northern holding two degrees. This degree has options in Accounting, Entrepreneurship and Hospitality.

OFFICE MANAGEMENT

The technical occupational specialty areas equip students with current technological skills while the business core requirements provide the essential foundation in business, accounting and office management. The Office Management degree is a cooperative program whereby students take their general education and business core courses from Northern Oklahoma College and their technical coursework at the Technology Centers of Autry-Enid and Pioneer-Ponca City.
