Program Outcomes

Performance on NCLEX

Campus firsttime NCLEX-RN pass rate at or above the national average for the calendar year.

Graduate NCLEX-RN pass rate 80% or above for all first-time test takers for the calendar year.

Program Completion

70% of students will complete the program within 200% of the program length beginning with the first transcripted course (8 semesters beginning with Fundamentals of Nursing).

30% of students who begin the Fundamentals of Nursing course will complete the program on time (4 semesters).

Program Satisfaction

90% of graduates will rate themselves as meeting the end-of-program learning outcomes "well" or "very well" at 6 months and 2 years.

90% of employers will hire/rehire Northern's graduates.

Job Placement Rates

90% of graduates will be employed as an RN within 6 months of graduation.

Academic Progression

50% of graduates will enroll in advanced education within 2 years of graduation.


Introduction



Gender Count 2021-2022









State Ratio





















The graph year indicates the calendar year of graduation. State and National data are reported two years post Institutional data.



Student Program Assessment 2020-2021


Evaluation Skills Lab and Equipment

The nursing skills lab and equipment are sufficient for learning.




Clinical Experiences

I had various clinical experiences.




Critical Thinking Skills
