

NOC Enid hosts NASA X-59 rollout

The Mackie Planetarium at Northern Oklahoma College Enid held a Public Watch Party for the roll-out of the new NASA X-59 aircraft Friday.

NOC Division Chair for Engineering, Physical Science, and Process Technology Dr. Frankie Wood-Black said this activity was made possible by NOC's involvement with NASA.

As part of NOC's watch party, several items were made available for use by students, teachers and aircraft enthusiasts including coloring sheets, paper airplane patterns, and paper desk models.

"I am very excited about this opportunity as NASA has helped to fund upgrades to our facilities and which allows for these types of events to be possible," she said. "It is just a natural fit for NOC and the City of Enid."

Lockheed Martin is the manufacturer of the aircraft. According to their website, the Lockheed Martin Skunk Works® team is solving one of the most persistent challenges of supersonic flight – the sonic boom. The X-59 will be used to collect community response data on the acceptability of a quiet sonic boom generated by the unique design of the aircraft. The data will help NASA provide regulators with the information needed to establish an acceptable commercial supersonic noise standard to lift the ban on commercial supersonic travel over land.

This breakthrough would open the door to an entirely new global market for aircraft manufacturers, enabling passengers to travel anywhere in the world in half the time it takes today.

NOC was one of 12 post-secondary locations in the United States hosting the rollout.

PTECH Applications accepted

Northern Oklahoma College has announced an extension for this year's applications to the Process Technology Program.

Students interested in the Northern Oklahoma College Tonkawa Process Technology Program focused on the Refining and Processing Industries have until March 15, 2024 to apply for the Fall 2024 semester. Only students who fill out the on-line application will be considered.

Program manager Frankie Wood-Black said the program is limited to 24 students. Wood-Black added the program is available to anyone interested in Process Technology, but they must fill out the application for this program, due to its high demand.

The review process begins in April, and applicants will be notified of the review process. The application may be found at <http://www.noc.edu/ptechapplication>.

Once the program is filled for the fall semester,

a waiting list will be maintained and individuals may be contacted prior to the beginning of the fall semester should an opening become available.

NOC also has a program designed for individuals seeking employment in the Renewable Energy Fields as well. The Wind Technician program has been growing with many individuals finding employment prior to the completion of their degrees. This two-year program does not require an application. Dr. Wood-Black indicated that classes for this program are available for Spring 2024.

Courses toward either the Process Technology and Wind programs are available during each semester.
