DAY 1-2:

TRAVEL TO PHILIP S.W. GOLDSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, IN-COUNTRY ORIENTATION AND A DELICIOUS DINNER

The group will arrive in Belize City and provided transport will take you to the home-base located outside of Belmopan. That evening, you will enjoy your first delicious meal and receive an orientation about Belize and the work ahead.

DAY 3-6: CLINIC DAYS AND EDUCATIONAL CHARLA FOR COMMUNITY MEMBERS

Each day, your program will travel from the lodging facility to your partner community to provide healthcare services and access to medications to community members along with local HCPs. You will be able to rotate between stations, shadow doctors and interact with patients. During the charla station, you will empower community members through educational charlas. Topics include chronic illnesses, mental health, and physical health among others.

DAY 7: CULTURAL ACTIVITY

Reflect on the experience and enjoy final cultural activities with community before returning to the lodging facility for final evening celebrations.

DAY 8: RETURN HOME

Tell friends and family the many amazing stories, friendships, and discoveries you made in Belize!

At the private home-base, you will enjoy authentic local cuisine. Participants stay in shared rooms accommodating 8-14 people of same gender, with private bathrooms. Private rooms for instructors and chaperones are typical and based on availability.

STAFFING

Incredible team members will be on call to support you every step of the way, as well as expertly-trained cooks, security guards, coordinators, and drivers. Coordinators and translators will be with the group at all times.

COMMUNICATION

Kambia staff can be reached 24/7 in the event of an emergency. Students will have limited to no access to the internet and phone reception. If you would like to call back home, feel free to reach out to your coordinator/PA for support. Trip updates may be posted on our blog/social media for friends and family to follow.

TERMS AND EXPECTATIONS:

Individual Program Fees include all in- country expenses, including meals, lodging, transport, scheduled activities, staffing, travel medical insurance, and volunteer project support. Estimated program fee includes airfare. Minimum group size is 10, excluding Faculty.
