STUDENT EMAIL

Your NOC email service is provided through Microsoft 365. Within this service you are able to access and install Microsoft 365 applications to your personal device. Microsoft 365 is an online/cloud-based service, so there may be some limitations to the applications if you are not online or do not have a reliable internet service.
