CAMP GOALS

Mass Drills

Mass Drills include work on ball handling, dribbling, passing, defensive stance, pivots, post defense and shooting form.

Station Drills

Station Drills include post offense and defense, layups, triple threat, pick & roll, team defense, dribbling with cones, shooting form, rebound & outlet pass, V cuts, L cuts, back cuts, passing, help and recover defense, weakside defense, how to communicate on defense and blocking out.

Team Transition Offense

Team Transition Offense includes floor balance, filling lanes, court spacing, advancing the ball and good shot selection.

Grades K-3

Day Camp 9:30-11:30 a.m.

Two lowered goals will be used for teaching offensive skills. Basics such as dribbling, passing, defensive and varied offensive skills will be introduced.

Insurance

All campers will be covered by an excess medical insurance policy provided by the camp.



Registration

Please make reservations in advance. The deposit or total amount must accompany reservations.

Our enrollment is limited. We will accept reservations as they are received. Final enrollment is to be completed the first day of each session. After we have received your application and deposit, you will receive an acceptance letter along with details regarding housing, arrival and departure times, and important phone numbers.

Facilities

Air-conditioned dorms will house our campers. Two gyms are available. Our college cafeteria provides all-you-can-eat meals.

What to bring

Towels and wash clothes, personal toilet articles, sheets and blanket for twin size bed, pillowcases, playing shorts, basketball shoes, athletic socks. Bring plenty of comfortable, casual clothes such as shorts and T-shirts.

T-shirts

T-shirts will be given to each camper. Be sure to indicate your size on the application form.

Camp Basketballs

All campers attending will receive a regulation size camp ball.

Camp Regulations

Campers will not be allowed off campus unless with an organized and supervised camp group. All visitors must secure permission through the camp director. Campers will be supervised by the coaches at all times.
