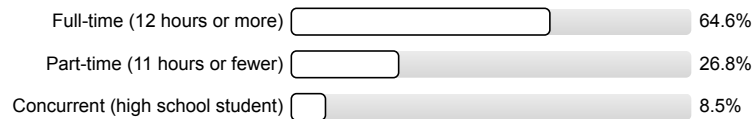

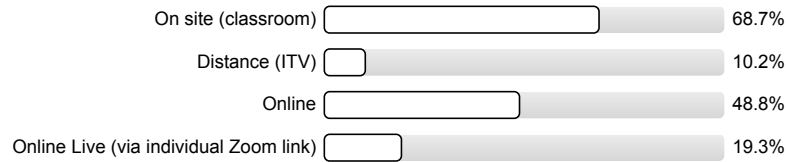

2.2) Comment 2.1

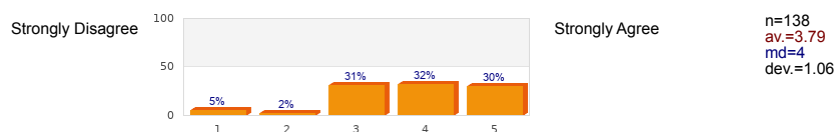
- XXXX did a great job helping me enrolled but I was not enrolled in all my classes during the year.

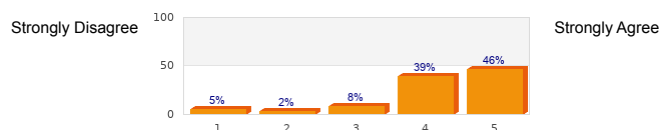


2.5) Comment 2.4

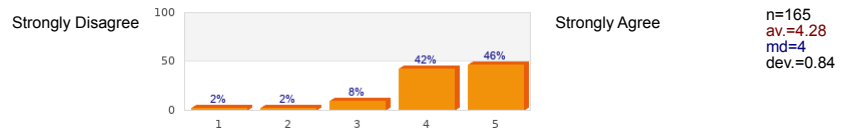

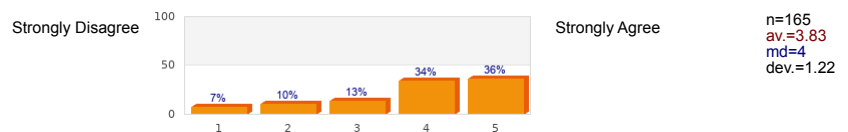


2.9) Comment 2.8

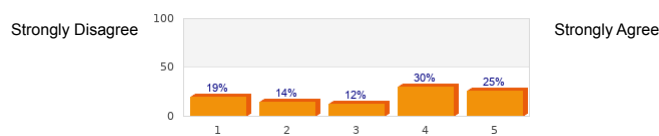


3.2) Comment 3.1

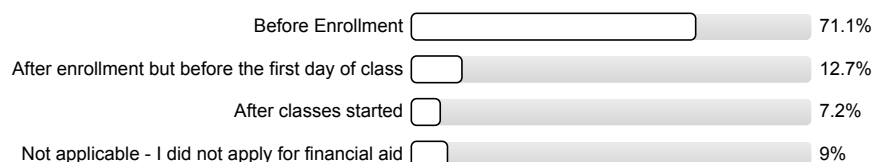

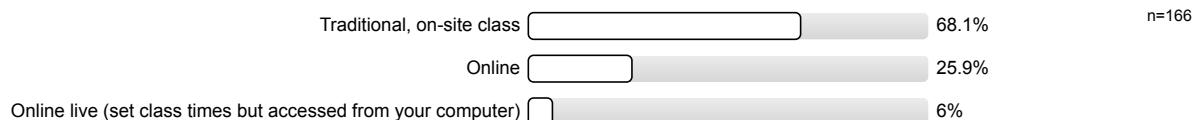

- I don't remember but the reason I had to take an extra semester before graduating was because the last two classes I needed were not available in the fall and only in spring.

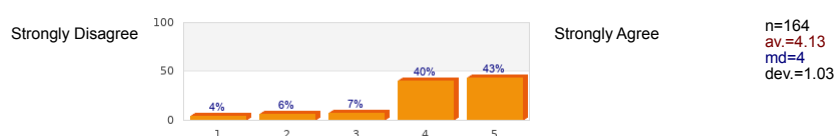

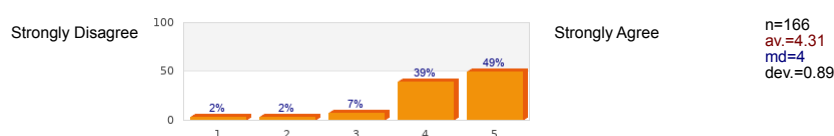


5.2) Comment 5.1

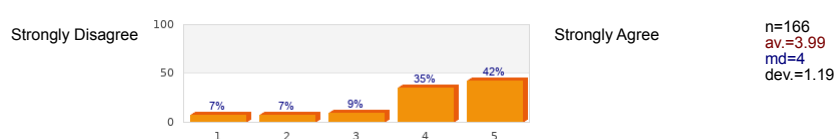

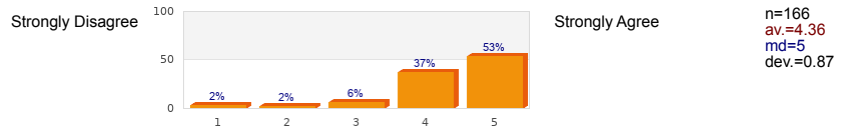
5.4) Comment 5.3

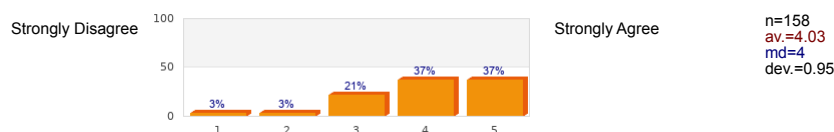
- I didn't use the electronic databases

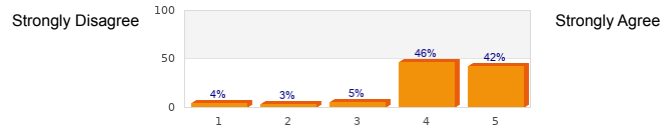
- All of our research labs are easily accessible.

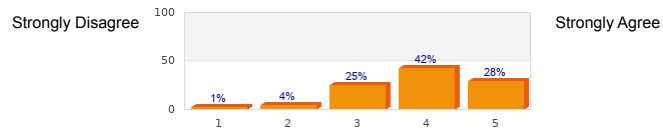

Or even a spirit week with unique dress-up days for students and staff to show off their school spirit or bring awareness).
