Residence hall rates reflect double-room occupancy. Dependent upon availability, a private room may be selected for an additional charge. Private room charge amounts are an additional \$1,557.50 per semester for Jets Hall, \$1,514.50 per semester for Lankard Hall, and \$1,212.25 per semester for E.B. Hall.

Fall semester room and board charges are due October 1, 2025.

Spring semester room and board charges are due March 1, 2026.

To avoid a 1.5% monthly (19.56APY) finance charge, room and board payments must be paid in full on or before the due date, or a payment plan must be in place. Payment may be mailed, paid online or paid in person at the Finance Office. Northern Oklahoma College accepts cash, check or debit card with a PIN at the cashier window. Credit cards are accepted online only. Pay online by going to www.noc.edu and logging into **myNOC**; click **Students, Billing** then **Review/Pay Account**.

Students receiving financial aid or scholarships should verify their accounts to ensure that awarded aid has been applied and is sufficient to cover charges. Any remaining balance must be paid in full or a payment plan must be set up.

A Student ID card will be issued upon initial enrollment. This ID card will serve as a meal card and door access card. Lost or stolen cards must be reported to the Finance Office. To replace a card, the student must come to the Finance Office, pay a \$10 card replacement fee and then go to the Registrar's Office to obtain a new card.
